The meeting was called to order.

Owen Todd and John Graupman of Bolton and Menk were present to discuss the potential of adding a reverse osmosis system to the water treatment plant. The water treatment plant was constructed in 2000 with the ability to have a reverse osmosis system installed. The City elected to forego installation of such a system at the time. A reverse osmosis system would reduce hardness and other contaminants to allow for residents to completely remove or significantly reduce the use of their in-home water softening. Bolton and Menk will look into Public Facilities Authority funding options as well as begin conversations with the MPCA on permitting for the discharge stream into the wastewater ponds.

A motion was made by Schmidt and seconded by Firle to adjourn the meeting. All voted in favor. None voted against. The motion was carried.
