Pool Closing:

The swimming pool will be closed in the event the pool becomes contaminated.

There are many ways the pool may become contaminated; but the pool will remain closed until the pool is cleaned and chemical levels are returned to normal. For your safety, water quality is monitored throughout the day.

Severe weather will cause the pool to close. Lighting and thunderstorms will cause the pool to close until the severe weather has left the area. At the first detection of thunder or lightning, the pool will close. Heavy rain, which affects the lifeguard's ability to detect an emergency, will cause the pool to close.

Inclement weather will cause the pool to close. For the comfort of swimmers, the pool will be closed if the air temperature is below 65 degrees.

Pool Rules and Policies:

- *Shower before entering the pool is required.
- *Any person with open wounds, and infectious or communicable disease may not enter the pool.
- *No spitting, spewing, or nose-blowing in the pool.
- *No running allowed in the pool area.
- *No food, beverages, or gum allowed in the pool area.
- *Swearing and vulgar language is prohibited.
- *Smoking is prohibited in the entire pool area.
- *No street clothes or cutoffs allowed in the pool.
- *No Flotation allowed in the pool area with the exception of family swim.
- *No hard balls such as baseballs, tennis balls, etc. allowed in the pool.

Wading Pool Rules:

- *Children must be supervised by a responsible person 14 years or older.
- *Children must be 6 years of age or younger to use the wading pool.
- *No diapers are allowed in the wading pool. Little swimmers are encouraged and are for sale in the pool office.

Telephone Usage:

The telephone is primarily for emergencies. We ask that you arrange times for pickup for individuals before entering the pool.

Lesson Cancellation Policy:

The first half of the cost of swimming lessons is due upon sign-up. This portion is not refundable if lessons are cancelled after the sign-up deadline for each session.
