Ordinance 455

An Ordinance Amending City Code Chapter 155-3 Abatement of Public Nuisances

WHEREAS, the City previously adopted ordinances defining public nuisances and the abatement process of nuisances, which are now codified as City Code Chapter 155;

WHEREAS, the City Council has determined an amendment is desired to Chapter 155-3, declaring public nuisances affecting peace and safety within city limits;

WHEREAS, The City Council held a public hearing on the amendment of ordinance on the 10th day of December, 2024, duly published and advertised as required by State Law.

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF FAIRFAX ORDAINS:

City Code Chapter 155-3 Abatement of Public Nuisances is hereby amended as follows:

Q. A property owner is not allowed to display outdoors for sale, or otherwise, personal property or household goods in a manner that is unsightly and distracting to a considerable number of people, or in a manner that is likely to create a fire, health, or safety hazards from such accumulation, or negatively affect neighboring property owner’s use, enjoyment or property value.
